After loading Boulder Dash Construction Kit, start the game from the title screen by pressing **RETURN**. If you chose to play the *Game Module* with two players, You will then have the following set of options: Choose the number of players (1 OR 2) and the number of joysticks (1 or 2) by pressing **F3**. Load **GAME1** by pressing **RETURN**. Select a cave or intermission to play by displaying the cave or intermission number (use the **cursor arrow** keys). Start the game by pressing **RETURN**. Pause and restart the game at any point by pressing the **SPACEBAR**. A formatted disk is required if you want to save your caves and intermissions on a seperate data disk.
